## Licence Requirements

Please make sure that your licence is correct and current (not out of date). No persons under the age of sixteen (16) years of age are permitted to compete at Bathurst.

## Fire Extinguishers

All vehicles MUST have at a minimum a 900 gram fire extinguisher secured in their vehicle, accessible by the driver as per Schedule H of the current CAMS manual. This schedule can be found on the CAMS website. The extinguisher cannot be older than 3 years from the date of manufacture (this will be stamped on the extinguisher).

## Pit Lane and Pit Lane Garages

**NO** persons under the age of sixteen (16) years of age are permitted in pit lane or any part of the pit lane garages. Penalties will be applied as per regulations item 2.8.1.2.

The wearing of thongs or sandals in pit lane is strictly prohibited. You must wear closed shoes.

## Supplementary Regulations

The Supplementary Regulations, entry form and fuel registration form are on the Challenge Bathurst website. NOTE the fuel form you send to RACE FUELS – not to me.

For returning competitors, you have already been issued with a CRN from a previous year. New competitors will have to send through their entry form and I will email you your CRN.

Please make sure you READ the supplementary regulations prior to submitting your entry. These will answer most of the questions. If you ask me a question that's already answered in the regulations I will just send you another copy.

## Documentation Required

The following documentation must be brought with you for the event.

- CAMS competitor licence (if different to the driver)
  - CAMS driver licence (if different to the competitor)
  - CAMS competition pass book
  - CAMS vehicle log book – if log booked / Road registered will need proof of ownership with a copy of the relevant state registration papers
  - Valid CAMS affiliated car club membership card
- If the vehicle is in the name of a company or other person, who does not hold a CAMS competition licence, a letter of authority must be provided at administration checking.
- If you need a CAMS bone fide legal owners document please contact the administrator and I will email you one.

## Merchandise Selling

The selling of team merchandise, or other products, at the Event is prohibited unless a merchandiser agreement has been entered into with the Organiser.

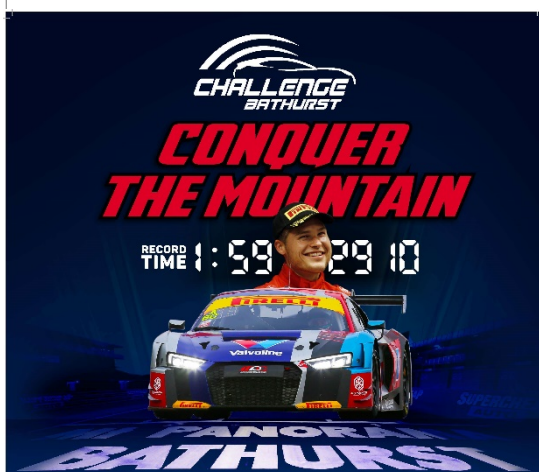
## Prohibited Vehicles

The use of any 2 wheeled motorised bike, hover board, moped, segway, skates, roller blades or scooters is prohibited in any paddock area at all times during the event.

See supplementary regulations 2.8.2.9 for allowed vehicles.

**DRONES (UAV) ARE PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES DURING THE EVENT.**

**FINES WILL APPLY FOR THE OPERATION OF DRONES.**



## Apparel

As per the supplementary regulations item

2.6.2.10.1 It is **MANDATORY THAT ALL DRIVERS MUST WEAR** a fire proof driving suit which must comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

2.6.2.10.2 Foot wear must be fully enclosed, and minimum of leather uppers. Nylon runners or gym shoes are **NOT PERMITTED**.

Competitors wishing to take advantage of this must quote their CRN to Racer Industries when ordering.

As from 2020 it will be a CAMS requirement that all drivers competing in a CAMS log booked vehicle, in a speed event must wear a FHR. Road registered vehicles are excluded from this requirement.

## Animals

Due to the risk of public disturbance, concern for the health of animals and in consideration of consequences to health and safety including injury to drivers and others which may result from the reaction of animals to the general environment experienced at motor race venues including:

- \* Loud and sudden noises including explosions;
- \* Sudden release of gasses;
- \* Sudden movement of persons and plant;
- \* Speed of race vehicles; and
- \* Generally the unusual (insofar as animals are concerned) environment experienced at a motor race circuit,

Dogs and other animals are not permitted to be brought into the venue of a motor sport event by able bodied visitors when the event is being held under the auspices of a CAMS permit.

Guide and companion dogs with the appropriate paperwork and attire are exempt.

## Markings on Vehicles

All markings provided by the Organiser are compulsory and must be fitted to the vehicles. If you present to the marshalling area without ALL the compulsory markings fitted you will not be permitted on the track until all markings are fitted, as per the regulations.
