CHAPTER 1 – GENERAL FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

2.1 Supplementary Regulation No 1, Chapter 1, Item 1.6.2.2.1 and 1.6.2.2.2 are replaced by the following:

- 1.6.2.2.1 Class A – Road Registered with No Modifications
(Can only use R-Spec and/or D.O.T Tyres)
Road Registered vehicles that also hold a Motorsport Australia Log Booked will be classified as per the Logbook, **7th Category Class KB.**
AA = 2WD
AB = 4WD
- 1.6.2.2.2 Class B – Road Registered with Modifications
(Can only use R-Spec and/or D.O.T Tyres)
Road Registered vehicles that also hold a Motorsport Australia Log Booked will be classified as per the Logbook, **7th Category Class KB.**
BA = 2WD
BB = 4WD

2.2 Supplementary Regulation No 1, Chapter 1, Item 1.6.2.2.7 is replaced by the following:

- 1.6.2.2.7 Class J – **2nd Category Log Booked Vehicles**
JA = Radical SR3
JB = Radical SR8
JC = Sports Racer
JD = Radical SR10
6th Category Log Booked Vehicles
JE = Aussie Race Car

2.3 Further Supplementary Regulation No 1, Chapter 1, Item 1.14 is replaced by the following:

- 1.6.2.2.8 Class K – **4th, 5th and 7th Category Log Booked Vehicles.**
KA = 5th Category Group A, C, N, S, Group M, O and Q Sports Cars vehicles only (all other 5th Category vehicles are not eligible).
KB = **7th Category Log Booked Vehicles.**
Excluding any Pro, Pro-Am and/or Open Class Time Attack vehicles.
KC = **4th Category Log Booked Vehicles.**
Excluding all Off Road Vehicles.

2.4 Further Supplementary Regulation No 1, Chapter 1, Item 1.8.1.5 is replaced by the following.

- 1.8.1.5 Competitors / Drivers are to park their respective trucks and/or transporter/s behind the white line marked next to the dish drain in the Inner Paddock, when the trucks tailgate is lowered the tail gate must be in line with the white line of the dish drain. No spots are reserved, it will be first come, first to set up. **All Shade Structures (whether, awning, marquee or pop-up) are Prohibited anywhere in the Inner Paddock Area,**
